

The **Life Skills/Game of Life Expo'** will take place on March 25th, 2015 This is a one-day game of life for 8th grade students, held at UW-Marinette. The "game" gives kids a sneak preview of life's financial challenges. After selecting a career and imagining life at the age of 29 (with the assistance of their school counselors) students spend the day at the Expo' making decisions on how to spend their monthly income: they select and make payments on a house (including utilities, taxes and insurance) make car and insurance payments, buy groceries, pay the phone bill, etc. For most participants, it's an eye-opening experience. Local businesses - realtors, insurance agents, grocers, car dealers and others - participate in the effort, helping kids learn. Approximately 450 students from area middle schools attend this event. **Sponsorships levels available; \$100 supporting sponsor, \$250 event co-sponsor, \$500 major event sponsor.**

The **Community Leadership Academy Class of 2015** is organizing a public art "**Yarn Bombing**" event in conjunction with the annual Art for All Festival to be held on June 28, 2015. The project is designed to enhance the Art for All Festival, draw people to the downtown event and businesses, and strengthen community ties by engaging businesses, seniors and children in the creation of the art pieces. Proceeds from the project will help to fund scholarships for area high school seniors pursuing degrees in the Arts this fall. **Sponsorships levels available; \$100 supporting sponsor, \$250 event co-sponsor, \$400 major event sponsor.**

This November the annual **Career Opportunities Expo'** will be held at one of our local high schools allowing for more hands-on demonstrations. Career Opportunities Expo' is a program developed for 10th grade students to help them further explore career options available in the Marinette Menominee area. Students will be introduced to various fields of work and the education necessary for those industries. Representatives from over 30 area companies both large and small will be invited to participate. Approximately 300 students from area high schools attend this event. **Sponsorships levels available; \$100 supporting sponsor, \$250 event co-sponsor, \$500 major event sponsor.**

These programs have all grown in popularity throughout the last few years.
